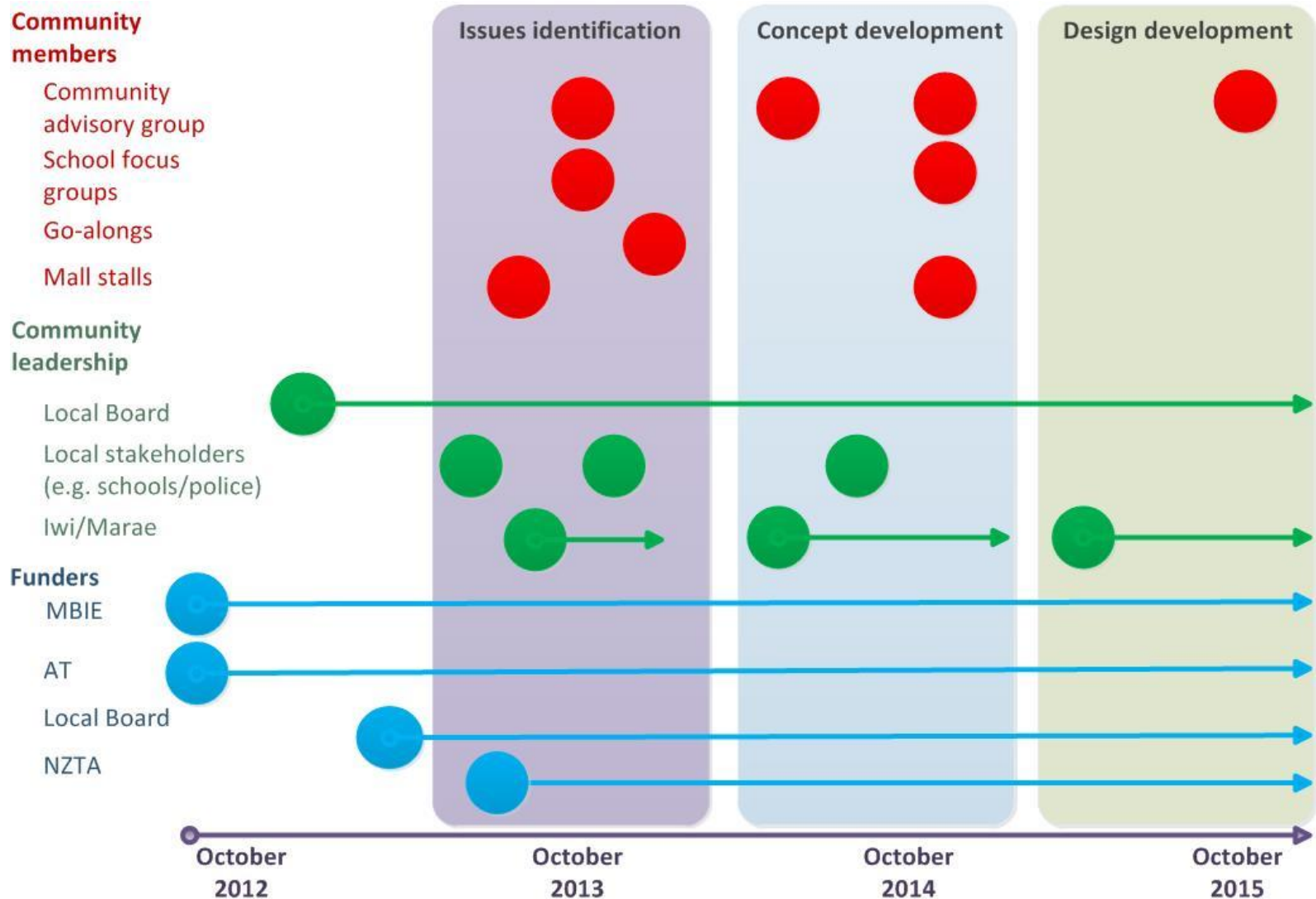


Participation timeline
